Re: Year 12 End of Year Exams Monday 3rd June to Friday 7th June 2024 (Without study leave)

I write to explain the arrangements for the Year 12 End of Year Exams, which Year 12 students will be sitting during the week commencing Monday 3rd June 2024 (first week back after the May half-term).

These Year 12 End of Year Exams will be held as in-class assessments, during lesson time, as opposed to in the schools main E amination Hall. This is because the Sports Hall and the E ams Room (S.1.16), ill alread be in use to facilitate this summers actual GCSE and A-Level/BTEC Level 3 public examinations. With larger Year 11 and Year 13 student cohorts than in previous years, we simply cannot now safely accommodate all the students collectively in the Sports Hall together. Therefore, use of the Sports Hall for the Year 12 End of Year Exams is not an option. Equally, we will have to compromise slightly on the delivery of access arrangements for Year 12 students during this week as our designated readers and scribes (our LSAs) will also be supporting our Year 11 and Year 13 students who are sitting public examinations, meaning they will not be available either.

Admittedly, this is less than ideal. However, Year 12 students have been working closely with their teachers across the academic year and subject staff will be facilitating access arrangements within the classroom as much as possible so as not to disadvantage any student. For example, extra time
